Rollout of Online Service for Reporting the Arrival of Food with Examination Notice

The Centre for Food Safety (CFS) of the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department announced that with effect from 31 May 2023, traders may submit the arrival report of food consignments issued with an examination notice through the <u>Food Trader</u> <u>Portal</u>, in order to handle matters concerning the clearance of the Japanese consignments imported by sea that are subject to radiation test.

For food consignments that require both clearance from the Hong Kong / Kowloon Office and radiation test by Food Import Control Office (Special Duties), importers are only required to submit one arrival report. The reported case will be forwarded to respective Offices for processing simultaneously. The importer will be notified through the FTP regarding inspection and release of the consignments. Upon completion of all the procedures, the CFS will issue a release letter through the FTP. For enquiries, please contact us.
